Please plan to attend our Association's Annual Meeting, which will be held on **Thursday, October 23rd**, at the Clague Middle School library. Sign-in begins at 6:30pm, and the meeting is scheduled from 7-9pm.

All homeowners have received a packet of information about the meeting from Your Peace of Mind, including proxy forms for voting. **Please attend** the meeting in person if you can; if you cannot attend, **please give your proxy** form to a neighbor who will be attending, whom you trust to vote on your behalf. Board members will be collecting proxies during the weekend and on Monday and Tuesday evening, but please feel free to email board@arbor-hills.org to arrange to have your proxy picked up at any convenient time. If neighbors who plan to attend the meeting could also help collect proxies from those they know who are not attending, this would be very helpful.

For this meeting, we need to have at least 70 (35%) of our homeowners represented, either in person or by proxy. Please make sure your vote doesn't go to waste!

At the meeting, we will be electing 2 Board members, to serve a 2-year term. Please consider volunteering to serve on the Board - it's a great way to make a positive difference for our neighborhood. To place your name on the ballot, contact Your Peace of Mind. Nominations will also be accepted from the floor at the meeting.

The meeting agenda will also include the 2015 Arbor Hills budget and a review of the Association's activities in 2014. We hope to see everyone on the 23rd!

Branches that overhang the sidewalk should be trimmed to a height that will allow pedestrians to walk underneath them safely. Also, we have been noticing some large wasp or hornet nests in some of the trees in our neighborhood. Please inspect your street trees for the presence of these types of nests, and consider safely removing them as a courtesy to your neighbors.
